

ISLAND GAMES ATHLETICS TEAM ASSISTANT

The role of the Team Assistant is to generally support the work of the team manager and team coach in the lead up to and during the period of the Island Games. The job is complex and varied but the main duties will include:-

- Attend athletics team meetings prior to and including the Games
- Participate in and help to organise fundraising events
- Assist with team coaching under the direction of the Team Coach
- Ensure athletes are up and ready, have a meal, have all their kit and are in good time to meet the transport to the track for training and competition sessions
- Ensure all athletes are on time to meet transport to return to the hotel following training and competition sessions
- General ongoing support to athletes and supervision of the younger athletes in the team
- Team Assistants must be in possession of a current athletics coaching licence, a satisfactory and current CRB check, and hold a current Child Protection Training certificate (or be willing to attend a Child Protection Training Course prior to the Games).
- Any other reasonable duties deemed necessary by the Team Manager/Team Coach.
